Who Should Attend? Government agencies, contractors, engineers, and construction managers wanting to gain an understanding of how to construct a quality asphalt pavement.

Cost: \$0 government agencies (sponsored by LTAP), \$275 non-members, and \$225 for HAPI members. Includes refreshments and all-day workshop also includes lunch.

The goal of the one-day workshop is to provide a basic understanding of materials, production, placement, and compaction operation that combine to produce a quality asphalt pavement. The workshop agenda is as follows:

- What is Quality?
- How is it achieved? Specifications
- Pre-construction Recommendations
- Mixture Designs
- Asphalt Production Facility

- Surface Preparation
- Materials Transfer
- Paving Operations
- Compaction
- QC/QA Testing
- Troubleshooting mat defects

Takeaways:

- An understanding of quality
- An overview of construction of an asphalt pavement
- An understanding of the importance of quality control

There will also be a Mentimeter quiz game for both the morning and afternoon sessions. The game will have three or four questions asked after each module. The questions posed are a review of the just completed module. The top finishers will be awarded a \$10 Starbucks gift card.

The 3-hour workshop on day 2 is called the "Next Level" and for a good reason. The workshop both expands on the previous day's discussion and applies the knowledge learned via the review of job site videos. In 2023, the expanded topics included paving steep slopes (Waipio Valley Road), paving flat slopes, paving in the rain, and pavement repairs. The workshop will end with the attendees being the "inspector" at various paving project sites. The "inspectors" reviewed videos and discussed the good and bad of the paving being done.

- Meeting fellow engineers from DOT, DLNR, Army, and NAVFAC. Playing Mentimeter games. Stories of paving projects from fellow agencies.
